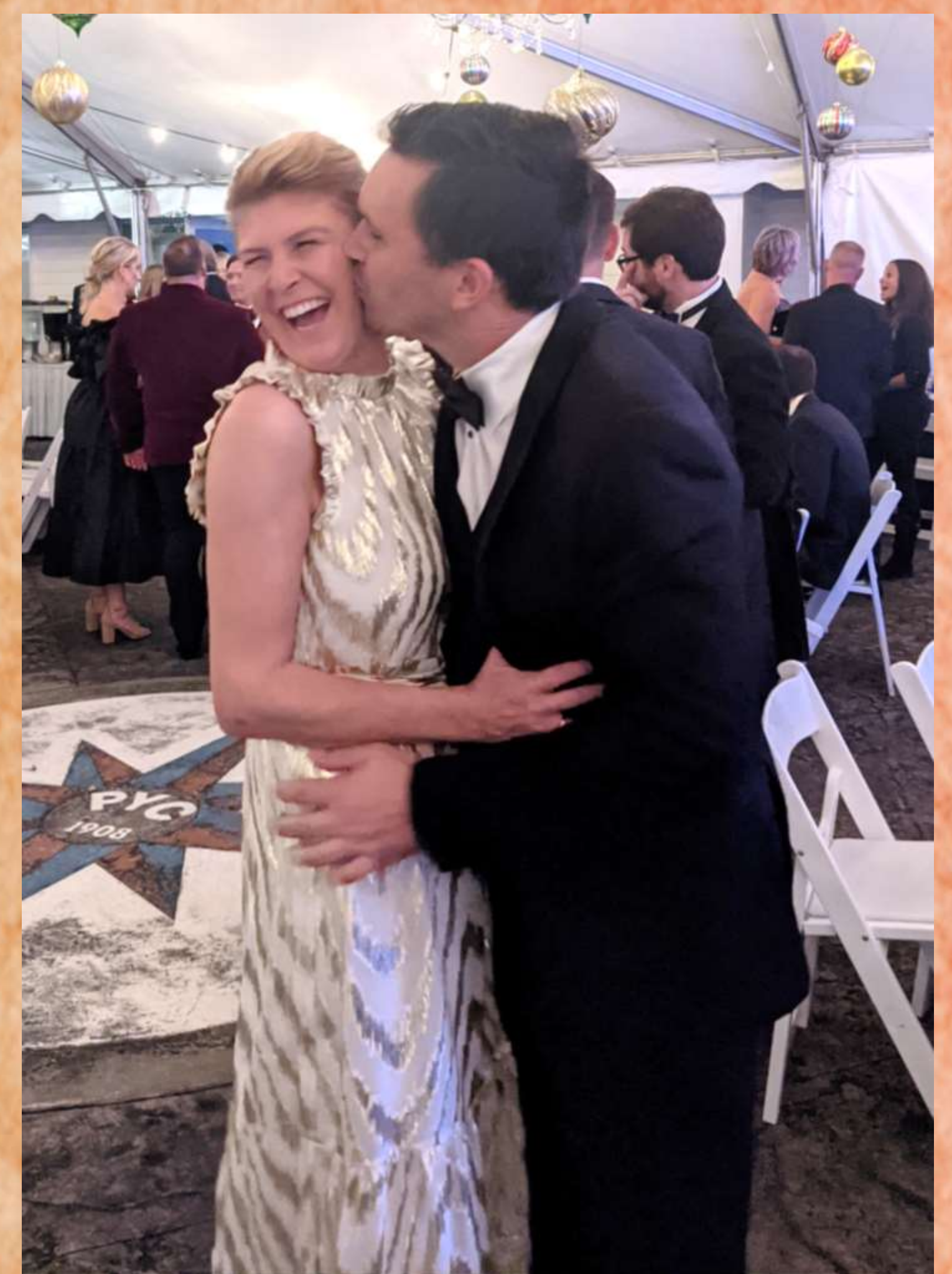
Values That We Will Teach Our Children

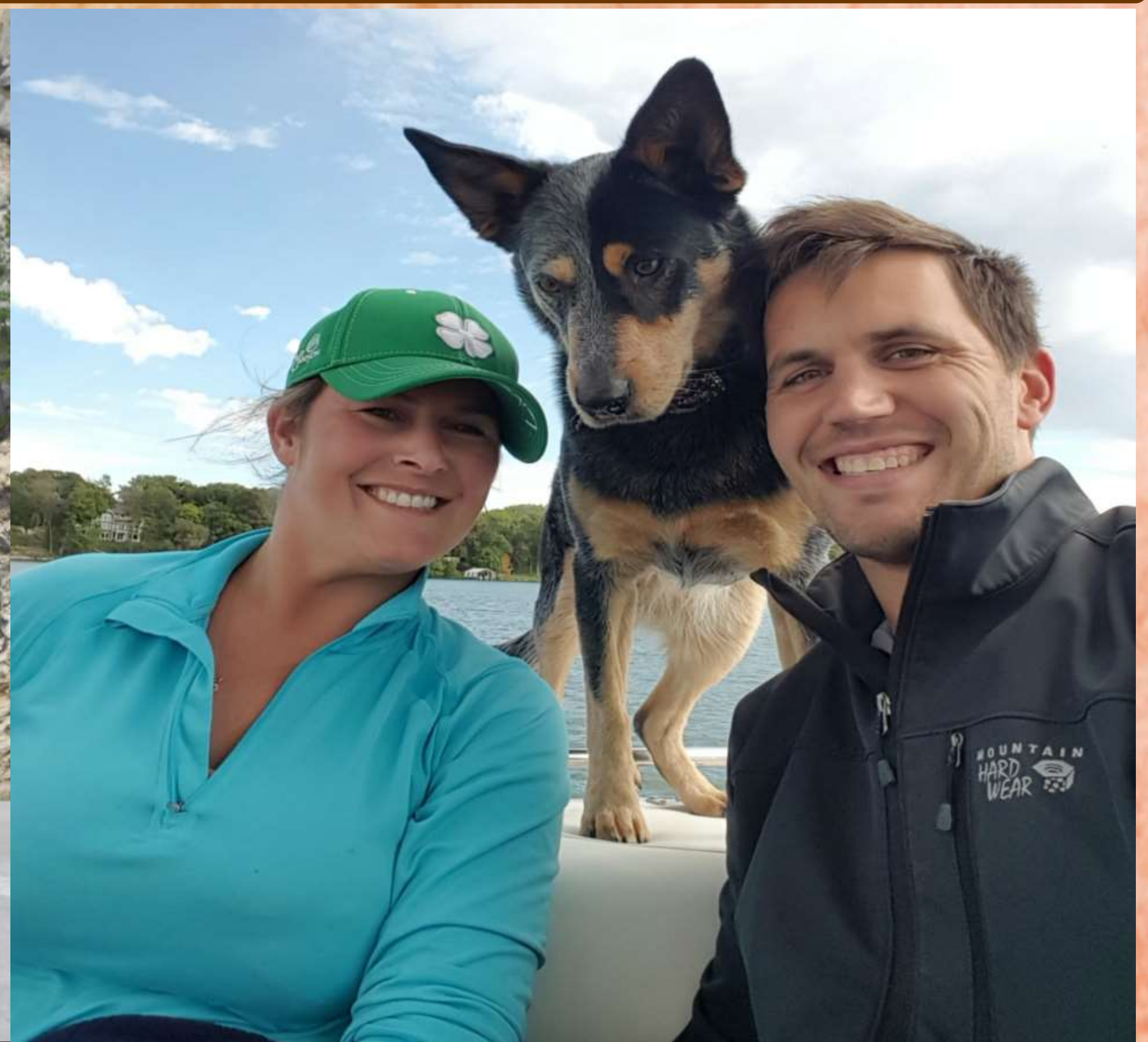


Why we chose *adoption*

ONE My parents live in Punta Mita, Mexico, for most of the year.

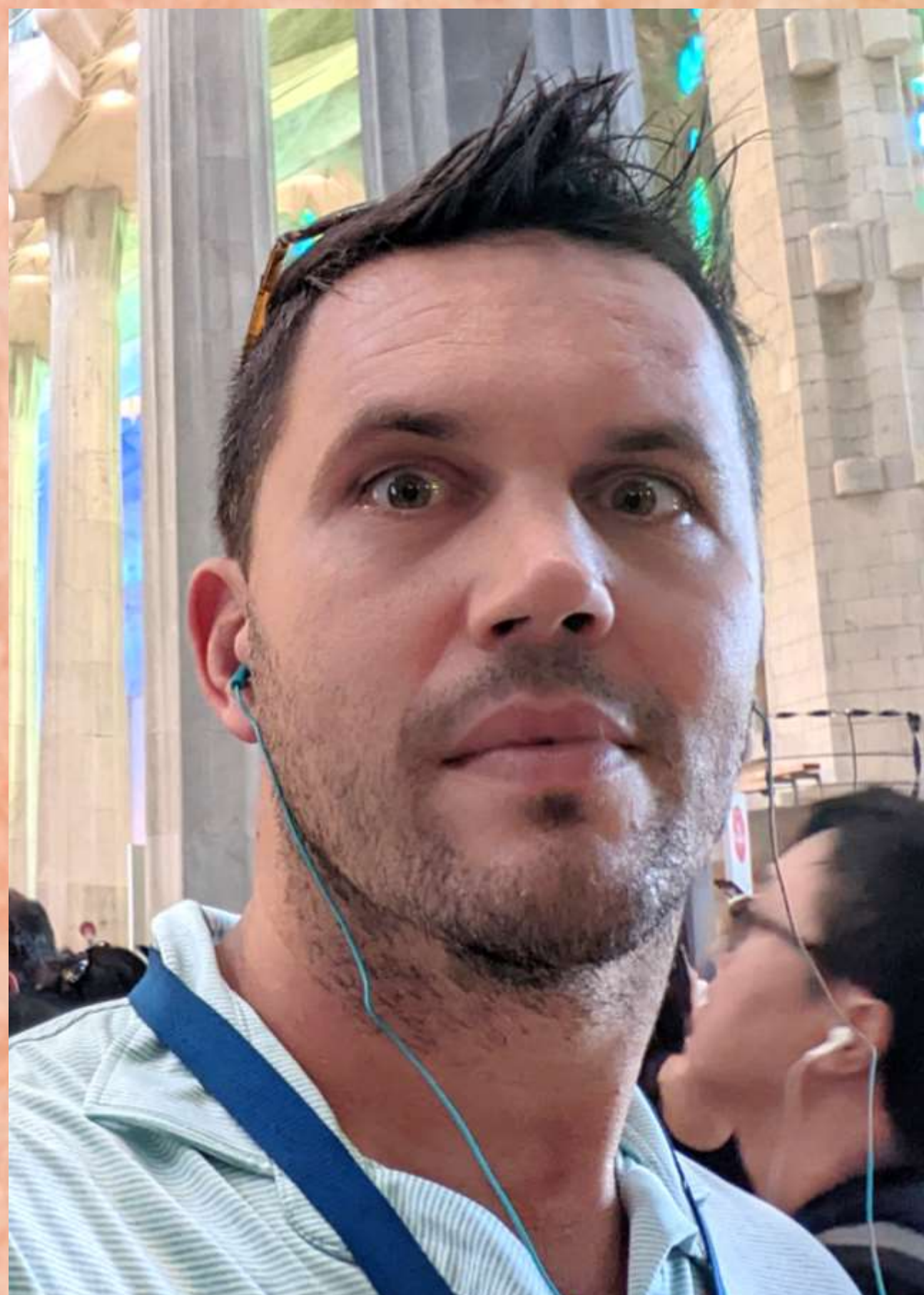
TWO In a very strange series of events, I got to drive a Ferrari from England across Europe to Monaco.

Where We Live

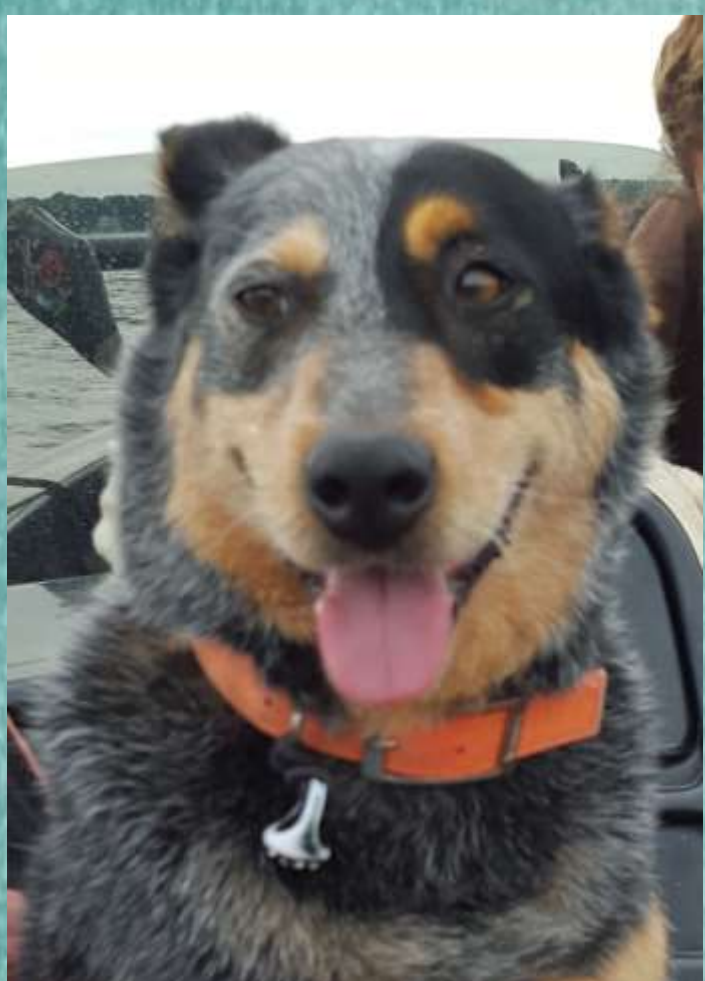
